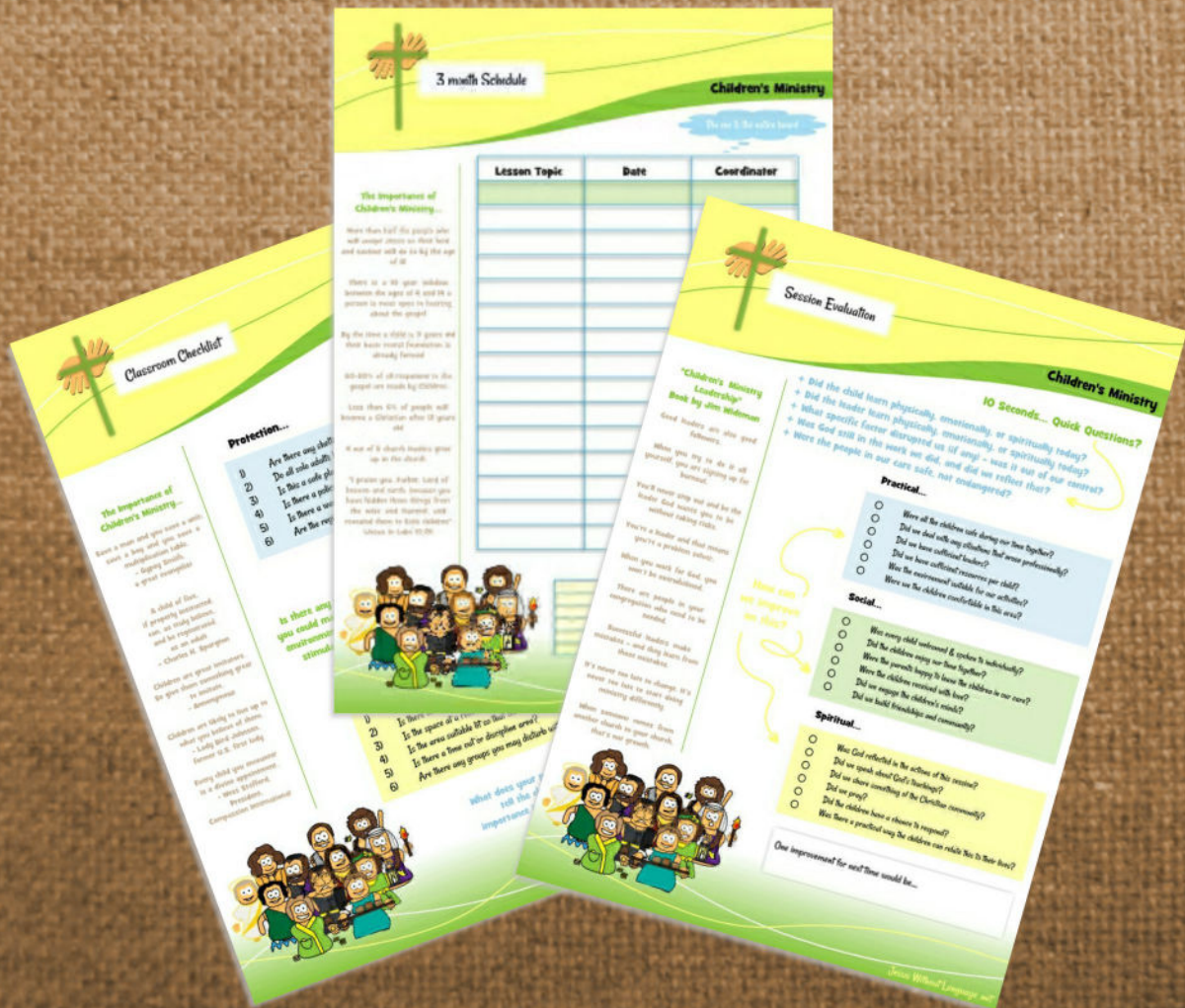

Classroom Checklist

Children's Ministry

What is the first thing a child will see?

(try walking in on your knees if you're not sure!)

Protection...

- 1) Are there any sheltered or reduced view areas?
- 2) Do all solo adults have clearance to work with the young?
- 3) Is this a safe place to talk?
- 4) Is there a policy for dealing with confidential conversations?
- 5) Is there a way of storing confidential information?
- 6) Are the registration and release forms to hand? (if used)

Safety...

- 1) Do you have enough adults?
- 2) Is the First aid kit in reach?
- 3) Is there anything sharp?
- 4) Is there anything to trip over?
- 5) Is there anything that could be toxic?
- 6) Is there any area that needs to be restricted?
