- 3) Is this a safe place to talk?
- 4) Is there a policy for dealing with confidential conversations?
- 5) Is there a way of storing confidential information?
- 6) Are the registration and release forms to hand? (if used)

- 6) Are there any groups you may disturb with noisy activities?
