


Sessions review A Sit-down chat



This review is designed for leaders to sit together and discuss. It's a good tool for assessing when the sessions feel stale or you are facing disagreements about how the session should work. While it asks about a specific session, you can use it for sessions in general too.

- Were all the children safe during our time together?
- Did we deal with any situations that arose professionally?
- Did we have sufficient leaders?
- Did we have sufficient resources per child?
- Was the environment suitable for our activities?
- How could we improve our space?

Social

- Were the children welcomed, spoken to individually and received with love?
- Were the parents happy to leave their children in our care?
- Did the group interact well together?
- Did we build friendships and community?
- Are we grouping appropriately, according to age and/or ability?
- Are there any who may be more comfortable in a different setting?

Spiritual

- How was God reflected in the actions of this session?
- Was the biblical message well communicated?
- Did we take time to pray and/or worship together?
- Did the children have a chance to question, wonder and respond?
- Was there a practical way the children can relate this to their lives?
 - Do we think our children are growing their faith?
